Whistles start playing **Chorus** - ukes need to change to [D] on "boys"

1-2-3-4

Chorus (whistles)

I'll [G] tell me ma, when I go home the [D] boys wont leave the [G] girls alone,

They pull me hair and stole my comb, and [D] thats all right till [G] I go home.

She is handsome, [C] she is pretty, [G] she is the girl from [D] Belfast City,

[G] She is courting [C] one two three,

[G] Please wont you [D] tell me [G] who is she

Verse 1 (No whistles)

[G] Albert Mooney says he loves her [D] all the boys are [G] fighting for her.

They knock on her door they ring on her bell saying [D] oh me true love are [G] are you well.

Out she comes as [C] white as snow, [G] rings on her fingers [D] bells on her toes,

[G] Old Jenny Murry [C] says she'll die if she [G] doesn't get the [D] fellow with the [G] roving eye.
